What is it?

The Australian Body Art Festival is Australia's premier body art event, attracting artists and spectators from across Australia and overseas to compete over 2 days in front of over 7,000 spectators! In addition to the extraordinary body art, visitors can expect a feast of other entertainment including wearable art, street performers, fabulous food stalls and music to groove to. There are also parades at the completion of each day. The event is a community event run by volunteers and is free for spectators.

Where is it?


This free event is being held in the heart of Noosa Country, at Mill Place in Cooroy. Cooroy is only a 20-minute drive from Noosa Heads or an hour and a half from Brisbane. 2017 was the first time the event is held at this location (previously held in Eumundi from 2009 to 2015) and it was a fantastic success with amazing feedback from artists, models, community, sponsors and spectators. We know it will continue to grow in future years.

When is it?

The 2018 Australian Body Art Festival will be held on **Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th April** and will be a "Festival of Colour" drawing together cutting-edge artists from around the globe, who will create masterpieces before your eyes using the human body as their inspiration – and canvas!

Who does it attract?


Over **7,000 spectators** attend to watch **dozens of competitors** create living canvases. Visitors and competitors come from across Australia and overseas. The Festival continues to amaze with its ability to attract a diverse range of people that keep coming back which makes it ideal for sponsors whether local, interstate or overseas. We attribute it to the amazing atmosphere - full of colour, fun and frivolity. Competition Naming Rights Sponsorship - \$1,500 (6 available)

Chose to be a naming rights sponsor for one of the six competitions – Brush & Sponge, Airbrush, Special Effects, Face Painting, Wearable Art or Photography.

1st Prize Sponsor - \$500 (six available)
